Business Recruitment

- 1) Project Quad—update was discussed in Executive Session
- 2) Project Buchannon—this is a metal products manufacturing company searching for 100+ acres in the Landmark Industrial Park to accommodate a 1,000,000 sq./ft. facility. They will make a site selection decision by the end of Q4 of 2023 or Q1 of 2024
- **3) Project Washington**—an aerospace company which would be a \$2,000,000--\$5,000,000 capital investment and would create 20-30 FT jobs

Business Retention and Expansion

1) Project Ranger—a local Fishing Bait Manufacturing company looking to expand and would be a \$500,000 capital investment with 5+ new jobs

- 1) Meeting with potential Retail Developer
- 2) Communication with retailers regarding potential sites
- 3) Working with Kimley Horn on scope of work to determine if we want to identify their firm for the Business Park
- 4) Engaged FX5 Construction to put waterline into Landmark Industrial Park
